LABOUR COUNCIL INVITES LOCAL CANDIDATES TO SUBMIT SURVEY

(PRINCE RUPERT, BC) The Prince Rupert Labour Council (soon to be formally renamed the "North Coast Labour Council") is surveying all declared candidates for the upcoming municipal and school board elections as part of its process for endorsing possible candidates.

Anyone who intends to run in an upcoming local election in a municipality or school board located in the North Coast Regional District is invited to download the survey at the labour council's website (<http://www.princerupertlabourcouncil.ca>). The deadline for returning a survey for consideration in the first round of possible endorsements is June 10, 2022.

An elections committee of the labour council will review surveys and may make endorsements for the upcoming election. To ensure that union members of local communities provide input on any endorsements for their community, it is expected that for some communities outside of Prince Rupert endorsements will be made sooner to the election date. Additional surveys may go out later to facilitate this. The labour council will decide more specifics of its endorsement process after hearing from the declared candidates at this time when the council meets again on June 23, 2022.
